Now in its sixth year, Shrewsbury Arts Trail continues its mission to bring unique and high-quality art to the town to be enjoyed by the public for free through a series of exhibitions and events at multiple venues. The Arts Trail celebrates our vibrant arts community, promotes the work of local and regional artists and boosts the reputation of our county as an exciting and welcoming cultural destination.

This year's theme is 'Impressions' and Shrewsbury Museum and Art Gallery is once again the venue for the 'Inspirational' exhibition featuring work by internationally renowned artists including the British Impressionist, Wynford Dewhurst, who was known as 'Manchester's Monet'. The exhibition also includes a specially commissioned monumental painting by Ian Rayer-Smith, inspired by Dewhurst's 'An Ancient Stronghold in France'.
